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CNSFund Overview

The Caithness & North Sutherland Fund was established by the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority, DSRL and Dounreay Stakeholder Group to distribute funding to community organisations for projects that will increase the attractiveness of Caithness & North Sutherland as a place to live, work and invest with particular emphasis on achieving environment, social, culture and infrastructure improvements.

A £4M funding package is being provided by the NDA as a planning condition of D3100, the low-level waste facility built near Dounreay. The NDA provided £1m at the start of construction in 2011 and £300,000 in 2014 and each year until 2023. The funding is distributed in line with the NDA's socio-economic policy and funding applications are assessed quarterly by the Caithness & North Sutherland Fund Community Benefit Package Committee.

Responsibility for the day-to-day management and funding decision-making of the CNSFund rests with the Board. The Board comprises of six individuals appointed to represent the local community as a result of an open application process and three Highland Councillors from Caithness & North Sutherland nominated by the Highland Council.

The CNSF CBP Committee (which is established by the Board) has responsibility only for considering and approving the distribution of grants. The members of the CBP Committee comprise of the Board and the Observers nominated by DSRL and the NDA. The role of the Observers is to gain an overview of governance and financial management and to ensure that funding decisions are in accordance with the NDA's socio-economic policy.

The CNSFund employs an administrative assistant and fund coordinator to administer the Fund and to coordinate the funding applications it receives, as well as manage the Fund's day to day operations.

The Board

Comprising (i) up to three individuals nominated by the Council; and (ii) up to six individuals elected by Members.

The CNSF CBP Committee

Comprising (i) the Board; and (ii) the Observers.



Chairperson's Report

It gives me great pleasure to present my report for 2021, which is the 10th year of the Fund's operation.

Since our last AGM report, the Fund has continued as usual and held four assessment meetings. We assessed fourteen applications and awarded £193,345.13 to thirteen community projects. These are wide ranging innovative ideas brought to us from every area, to enhance and improve the community experience.

Compared to previous years however there has been a decrease in the level of applications and consequently money that has been committed. This has mostly been as a direct result of the pandemic and we are led to believe that other funding bodies have noted the same downturn.

In addition to the usual meetings, the Board undertook a review of its processes as we felt we needed to update ourselves. As a result, it has helped to ensure that everyone involved with the Fund is comfortable and clear on all of our operating procedures. A Facebook page has been established and a poster campaign is ongoing to raise widespread awareness of our existence.

As part of the review, we also introduced a 12-month moratorium on all organisations who had applied to us three or more times since our inception. The purpose of this was to encourage other groups who had not previously applied and to ensure that as many groups as possible in the area can benefit. We plan to review this policy in April.

We were recently audited and the findings continue to be consistently good, showing a well-run operation. Our feedback from applicants also continues on a positive note.

Over the summer, we carried out an open recruitment process for candidates to fill a vacancy that had arisen. The directors were very grateful for all the interest shown and the outcome has resulted in Kayleigh Nicolson being nominated for election as an appointed director at this year's AGM.

I would like to thank Mary-Jane Statham, June Love DSRL and David Wallace NDA who are always supportive in their roles as Observers. I also thank them for providing use of DSRL's conference call provision which has allowed us to conduct our meetings in a safe manner during these worrying times. A mention should also go to Louise Calder who helped design our new poster.

In many ways this has been a difficult year all round. Understandably, folk are very wary of the virus and volunteers have become weary. A different perspective and method of working has made many people uneasy. However hopefully with time, momentum will build again and we can look forward to a raft of exciting projects being brought to our

As chair, I would like to thank former chairs who made my transition into this role much easier. Listening to and learning from them has taught me a lot. I would also like to take this opportunity to thank the present board members for their support and diligence over the past year and their enabling outlook on projects which has been a joy and privilege to be part of.

Thanks also goes to our staff David Shearer and Paula Davidson who have both continued to work from home. Thankfully a few spells in the office have now been possible. I would like to acknowledge their dedication and resilience during the current pandemic and the support they have given me in my new role.




2021 Statistics Report



Our funding is distributed in line with the NDA's socio-economic policy and must benefit people living in the Dounreay travel to work area. Since launching in 2011, the Fund's Community Benefit Package Committee has held **39** assessment meetings and has assessed a total of **238** funding applications.




The Fund has committed a total of £2,733,647.88 towards 201 community projects with a total value estimated to be in excess of £13 million. The projects are wide ranging and deliver a major improvement impact throughout the Dounreay travel to work area under one or more of our improvement themes.



Geographic Allocation

The funding is distributed to a wide range of projects, benefiting communities throughout the Dounreay travel to work area. The map below shows the Fund's catchment area as well as a breakdown of the geographic allocation of the funding approved by the Fund's Community Benefit Package Committee.



Project Investment Value

The **201** improvement projects being supported by the CNSFund are projected to attract over **£9m** in partnership funding. Community groups are also contributing an in-kind value of around **£500k** toward these projects. This gives a total estimated project value of over **£13m**. A geographic breakdown of this is shown in the table below.

2020 Round 4 Grant Awards

Strathnaver Museum Award £30,000

Towards the costs of installing professional interpretation designs that will create new, innovative exhibition displays and improvements to access and visitor flow, as part of the museum's major redevelopment plans.

Farr North Community Development Trust Award £24,216

To help with the costs of establishing the new development body, which has been formed following a community consultation. The grant will be used towards the community trust appointing a manager and development officer in order to take forward numerous development priorities identified in local community plans.

Advocacy Highland Award £11,283.50

To establish a Young People's Advocacy Pilot Project in Caithness & North Sutherland that will help to support young people aged 11-16yrs old who are in need of advocacy support.

Wick Gala Committee Award £5,356.80

To help refurbish the Wick Riverside Boating Shed roof to protect and improve the community building that will enable the gala body to continue to make use of the facility as a safe and secure base to run the annual gala as well as to support other community activities.

Reay Golf Club Award £5,000

To refurbish its clubhouse exterior that will preserve and enhance the golf club building to provide an attractive and modern recreational facility for the community and visiting golfers to enjoy.

2021 Round 1 Grant Awards

Farr High School Parent Council Award £4,029.80

To help deliver a creative project involving local children to design and construct iconic sculpture signposts to install at each of the North Coast Campus schools. The purpose of the sculptures is to represent and promote the culture and heritage of the North Sutherland school campus.

2021 Round 2 Grant Awards

Bower Busy Bees ELC Award £20,000

To help create a purpose-built outdoor shelter facility that will enable the rural early learning centre to offer pre-school children a much better and engaging outdoor learning experience. The outdoor facility will consist of a cabin structure equipped with an adjoining composting toilet as well as being wheelchair accessible.

Dunbeath Preservation Trust Award £23,650

Towards the costs of creating a new Development Officer post. The Trust manages the Dunbeath Heritage Centre and the new role will enable the Trust to recruit and train more volunteers as well as enhance the heritage museum's social media presence. A community engagement programme and community consultation will also be carried out to help inform an action plan for utilising the Trust's historical buildings.

Helmsdale Crafty Sew & Sews Awarded £23,329.73

To buy new sewing machines, equipment and materials. The new equipment will used by the group's volunteer sewers to upcycle used or unwanted materials and convert them into second life items for environmental and community benefit. Based at the Helmsdale Community Centre, the group will also provide community workshops and events to promote the learning of sewing and craft fabric skills as well as raising awareness of the environmental impact of materials and unwanted items going to landfill.

North Coast Connection Award £2,573.47

To carry out improvements to the Kyle Centre's community garden. The charity manages the community wellbeing centre at Tongue and provides a range of activities to older people and other groups, helping to address rural isolation. The centre uses produce from the garden for its popular community lunch club. The improvements will include installing new raised beds and new path work to improve garden access. Other improvements include display information and the creation of a memories garden area.

Thurso Players Award £7,000

For the drama group's history display project to create a large wall panel history display that will portray the evolution of the Mill Theatre complex and the history of the Thurso Players. The multi panel display will be designed from a series of engagement workshops that will be captured using new IT equipment. The history display will be installed in the Mill Theatre as part of a preliminary phase of activities to support the group's Foundry building restoration plans. A new theatre piece and website enhancements will also be undertaken.

2021 Round 3 Grant Awards

Wick Golf Club Award £30,000

towards the costs of creating a new workshop and coaching facility at the Wick Golf Club grounds. The new building will be used to support the golf club's machinery and maintenance requirements as well as being used for indoor coaching.

Crossroads Primary School Parent Forum Award £6,905.83

to help with the costs of creating a new outdoor activities facility within the rural school's playground. The facility will consist of a classroom cabin structure and will be used to provide a wide range of extracurricular outdoor activities to support young people's development.

"We were overwhelmed by the support that we have received from the CNSFund. After applying, the fund encouraged us to consider a better facility that would offer the children a more meaningful outdoor learning environment. We are now looking forward to getting our new facility built which the children will use for wildlife and gardening activities, craft activities and exercise sessions as well as for after school clubs and events."
